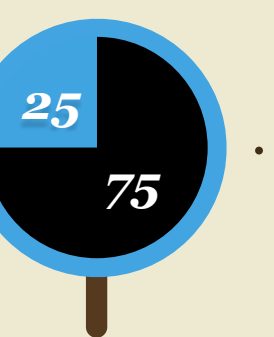
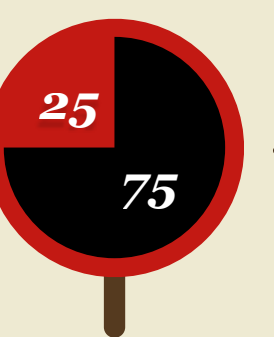
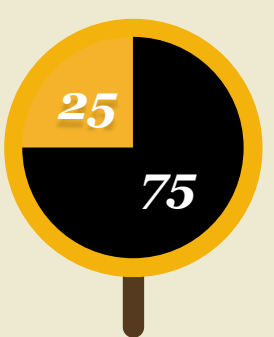
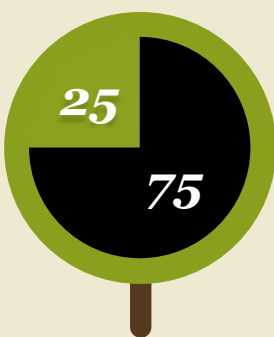


Hearing loss currently affects people **10 MLN**
